Redevelopment Plan Presentation Set For This Week

Board of Directors meeting scheduled for Wednesday, Jan. 10, at 9 a.m.

(Duluth)—The Gwinnett Place CID's Board of Directors will consider a number of important initiatives during its first meeting of the new year, including the introduction of a master plan for revitalizing the county's Central Business District.

Marsha Anderson Bomar, president/founder of Street Smarts, will present the CID's Comprehensive Redevelopment Plan – a guiding resource focused on land use, pedestrian access, traffic circulation and urban design as well as strategies for stimulating reinvestment.

Other topics to be consider this week include the following:

- A landscaping master plan for the south and north ramps of Steve Reynolds Boulevard and the south ramps of Pleasant Hill Road
- A way-finding master plan to ease traffic congestion
- Conceptual plan to increase mobility along Pleasant Hill Road and the Pleasant Hill Road/I-85 interchange

The Gwinnett Place CID Board of Directors will meet on Wednesday, Jan. 10, beginning at 9 a.m. The meeting will be held in the first-floor conference room of the Gwinnett Commerce Center – 3700 Crestwood Parkway in Duluth.
